

### **Drainage District Phase 4 Work**

Construction work for this Phase was completed successfully and accepted by the County in the Fall of 2014. Work included street removal (yet retaining some surface as asphalt walkways), infiltration basins, lift stations, walkway bollards, and driveway relocations at Tuna, Sturgeon and Perch. The County now reports all pumps in the system are working well and there are no issues with the entire drainage system's operation; the County will continue to monitor and maintain the system to assure it continues to work as designed.

### **Trex Walkway Work**

This past Winter, the County had additional Drainage District work completed. To maintain design consistency and to reduce the area of impervious surface, this work included removal of the four existing asphalt walkways on Tuna, Sturgeon, Perch, and Sailfish. They then were replaced with Trex walkways, identical to all the others on the former east-west roads.

As before, County Engineer Eric Weatherly will attend the Spring meeting and be available to answer any questions from WPOA members regarding Whalehead's Drainage System.
