
All Corolla paved road owners received mail this week advising them of a hearing in Currituck on May 21st 2018 for the purpose of 'receiving public comments on the proposed creation of the Corolla Fire Protection Service District.'

Many have wondered why such a meeting and for the answer we went to the president of the Corolla Fire Department Association, Tim Bostaph. Tim's response:

'Agree it seems backward but the vote in May is really about establishing the tax within the district which will become effective in FY 2018-19 (July 1). County is using OT and SAFER grant in the meantime.

The district was actually established by the county in early April when Corolla was separated from lower Currituck.
